

Student Code of Conduct

WTM London 2017

Students should be accompanied to World Travel Market by college tutors or lecturers and must be pre-registered for the event. Applications will be considered on a first come first served basis. All students must adhere to the Student Code of Conduct.

Admission

Every student group is allowed two free (including registrant) tutors to accompany the attending students. Additional tutors over and above this are charged at £29 per tutor. Student groups must be accompanied by a tutor at all times. Tutors are required to accept responsibility for their students as a condition of entry.

MBA and PhD students may attend without a tutor present only if a letter of approval from their tutor has been submitted along with their application to attend.

Student groups are automatically assigned e-badges to attend on Wednesday 8 November however there is a restriction of 1,000 places. Attendance on Tuesday 7 November is strictly at the discretion of WTM and will only go on general sale once Wednesday 8 November has sold out.

An admission charge of £29 (+VAT) per student applies or £24 (+VAT) per student for groups of over 20. WTM cannot refund any students places once bookings have been confirmed.

Behaviour

WTM London is a professional business to business event. Students are asked to consider their actions and behave in a responsible manner throughout the duration of the exhibition, with the promise of being conducive to retaining the goodwill of exhibitors.

We understand that students may need to gather research from exhibitors so we ask them to introduce themselves as such to exhibitors, and display their official badges at all times.

Students should be reminded that inappropriate actions of only one or two students could result in the removal from the exhibition and jeopardise the future attendance of students from their establishment.

Personal Appearance

Centre or company uniforms (if applicable) should be worn. If uniforms are not worn, appropriate formal business occasion should be worn. Casual clothes (jeans, trainers, hoodies, tracksuits and caps) are not acceptable. Please wear your student badge at ALL times.

Acceptance of Hospitality

Students under 18 must abide to UK regulations associated with drinking alcohol and smoking tobacco. WTM London organisers reserve the right to remove any student not adhering to this Code from the event with no refund.
